Bell's 1st ring. As the bell rings, please find your seat and pray silently for the next few minutes. Please refrain from conversations as these disturb those trying to pray.

The St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi bell at Ray Of Hope Church, 380 W. 1st St. in Elmira, NY, was a gift from Michael Quinnell of Syracuse, NY, in September 2005. The bell rings out 39 joyful rings, in contrast to tolling the bell in single rings. The 39 joyful rings honor the 39 lashes Jesus endured, and we now celebrate in victory and gratitude for our Salvation. "The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes, we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5) We ring the bell before worship and Bible Enrichment sessions. Listen carefully and see if you can hear all 39 rings.

Leader – 2: Thank you for spending your Palm Sunday morning with us. You are as welcome here as Christ Jesus himself. In Romans Chapter 15:7, the Scriptures instruct us to:

ALL: "Welcome one another, then, as Christ welcomed you, for the glory of God." (NABRE)

Leader -1: You are as welcome here as Christ Jesus himself. (** Reader, stop, look up at the people, and smile.***) Show the glory of God by introducing yourself and welcoming the **SAINTS** around you. To be extra careful, we observe COVID-19 safety protocols by waving across the room and into the camera for the Internet.

Pastor: Good Morning, **SAINTS!** I ask you, in whose Name are we meeting?

ALL: We meet in the name of God our Creator, Christ Jesus Our Lord and Saviour, and in the name of the Holy Spirit. Amen

Ray Of Hope Church officially began on 10/31/1983.

Today is March 24, 2024, Palm Sunday, the start of Holy Week in our 41st year of ministry. **Holy Week, 2024, celebrating the week that changed everything.** I would like us to think about the women with Jesus and what this week was like for them.

With our whole heart, mind, and soul, we begin to worship God in the beauty of holiness, spirit, and truth. (Psalm 96:9; John 4:23-24)

ALL: Together, we give God thanks and praise.

Leader -2: It would be ideal to gather outside this morning, down the street. We could have banners, musicians, instruments, and palms. We could sing hymns and announce our celebration by remembering Jesus's Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem at the start of his Passion Week, coming up the street and into our beautiful double doors.

Leader – 3: Jesus entered the City of Jerusalem on the date foretold by the Prophet Daniel over 400 years earlier. We have that prophecy preserved in the Bible in the Book of Daniel. It is easy to do the math and see that anyone studying the Holy Scriptures should have recognized Jesus as the Suffering-Servant Messiah.

ALL: Many people recognized Him and came together to give Jesus honor and praise. They waved palm branches in procession before Him and spread their cloaks on the ground, forming a royal welcome mat from what they had.

Pastor: Today's first act of worship is to remember and thank God for this great event by blessing and waving palm branches to celebrate the Holy Name of Jesus, our Lord and Saviour. A couple of weeks ago, Ian watched and listened to Pastor Charles Stanley give a sermon about the Holy Spirit. Pastor Stanley emphasized that all the work of God is done through the action of the Holy Spirit in the Church Age. I told Ian that this is called an epiclesis, or a blessing-action of the Holy Spirit, where the action causes change. Here is one of those epiclesis prayers, and there will be many during Holy Week. With this prayer, we ask God to make these palm branches holy.

Together, we pray this blessing:

ALL: O God, in the Name of Jesus, we, your faithful people, ask your **Only One and Holy Spirit to bless and separate these palm branches and other items we shall wave in your honor, for Christ's purpose. Let them be a constant reminder of your Triumphal Entry into our hearts. Come, Lord Jesus, Come into our hearts and set us free. Teach us to follow you in joyful procession all the days of our lives. We ask this in the Name of Jesus, Amen.**

Leader – 4: We go forth now, in a VIRTUAL PROCESSION, with palms and loud singing as we sing together The King Of Glory.

This year, while I play the piano, you who are out there with us on camera and everyone in the chapel, wave the palm branches (or whatever branch you can find to wave) on the refrain of the first song to spiritually welcome Jesus afresh into our lives. We will bless the branches and whatever you have just now.

WE PREPARE OUR HEARTS

+ Confession and Forgiveness of our sins.

Leader -2: Please be seated. (wait) So far, we gathered together, greeted one another, and praised God in song. Now, we prepare to accept God's renewal when we listen to the Word and the Holy Scriptures by reflecting on our relationships with God and others in silent prayer. Christ is present and listening to receive the silent confession of our faults, sins, and failures. He promises to forgive our sins immediately.
(silent prayer)

Leader -2: We pray together:

ALL: I confess to Almighty God, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have sinned through my own fault in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done, and in what I have failed to do. I declare in the midst of this assembly of believers that I am truly sorry for having offended anyone, and God, in any way. **Therefore**, I ask you, my brothers and sisters, all the angels and the saints, to forgive me and pray for me to the Lord our God.

Leader -4: Hello. My name is _____, and I am in the City of _____ in the State of _____.

Leader -4: Almighty and loving God, you continue to bless the Human Race with a spectrum of ethnicities and cultural traditions. You have made us many and yet one Body in You. So that people everywhere would learn to embrace the full spectrum of your love expressed in the Human Race, we pray, Lord, have mercy.

ALL: Lord, have mercy.

Leader -4: Christ Jesus, Our Lord, you are actually and truly present in your church. You call us to proclaim God's glory, praise God, live for God, and to guide others to God. Give us the courage to tell others about your imminent return and future kingdom openly; we pray, Christ, and have mercy.

ALL: Christ, have mercy.

Leader -4: Holy Spirit, you are with us as the Helper, the Comforter, our Advocate, our Intercessor – Counselor, our Strengthener, the one who will always support us. You inspired the people close to Jesus to study the Scriptures and know who He was. So that we would seek to understand you in our study of the Scriptures, we pray, Lord, have mercy.

ALL: Lord, have mercy.

L-4: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the World; have mercy on us.

ALL: Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the World, grant us peace.

Pastor: We pray that all of God's people may one day be united in God's Kingdom without the loss of anyone. Therefore, we ask Almighty God to have mercy on all of us, forgive all our sins, and keep us in everlasting life.

ALL: Amen.

Pastor: Please rise as you are able to give God thanks and praise for the forgiveness of our sins by praying the Gloria. The Church has prayed this prayer since the earliest records of worship services.

Christ's Sacrifice Once for All

10 Since the law has only a shadow of the good things to come and not the true form of these realities, it^[a] can never, by the same sacrifices that are continually offered year after year, make perfect

those who approach. ² Otherwise, would they not have ceased being offered, since the worshipers, cleansed once for all, would no longer have any consciousness of sin? ³ But in these sacrifices there is a reminder of sin year after year. ⁴ For it is impossible for the blood of bulls and goats to take away sins. ⁵ Consequently, when Christ^[b] came into the world, he said,

"Sacrifices and offerings you have not desired,
but a body you have prepared for me;

⁶ in burnt offerings and sin offerings
you have taken no pleasure.

⁷ Then I said, 'See, I have come to do your will, O God'
(in the scroll of the book^[c] it is written of me)."

⁸ When he said above, "You have neither desired nor taken pleasure in sacrifices and offerings and burnt offerings and sin offerings" (these are offered according to the law), ⁹ then he added, "See, I have come to do your will." He abolishes the first in order to establish the second. ¹⁰ And it is by God's will^[d] that we have been sanctified through the offering of the body of Jesus Christ once for all.

Jesus's Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem

11 When they were approaching Jerusalem, at Bethphage and Bethany, near the Mount of Olives, he sent two of his disciples² and said to them, "Go into the village ahead of you, and immediately as you enter it you will find tied there a colt that has never been ridden; untie it and bring it.³ If anyone says to you, 'Why are you doing this?' just say this: 'The Lord needs it and will send it back here immediately.'"⁴ They went away and

found a colt tied near a door, outside in the street. As they were untying it, ⁵ some of the bystanders said to them, "What are you doing, untying the colt?" ⁶ They told them what Jesus had said, and they allowed them to take it. ⁷ Then they brought the colt to Jesus and threw their cloaks on it, and he sat on it. ⁸ Many people spread their cloaks on the road, and others spread leafy branches that they had cut in the fields. ⁹ Then those who went ahead and those who followed were shouting,

"Hosanna!

Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!

¹⁰ Blessed is the coming kingdom of our ancestor David!
Hosanna in the highest heaven!"

¹¹ Then he entered Jerusalem and went into the temple, and when he had looked around at everything, as it was already late, he went out to Bethany with the twelve.

Hosanna.: "The multitude spread their garments to prepare the way for their meek, though glorious King; they cut down branches from the trees to bear Him testimony; and He is conducted in triumph to Jerusalem, while the people cry, "Hosanna [Save now] to the Son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest!"

During The Stations of the Cross, which we will celebrate Friday, women have a prominent presence: the Fourth Station, Jesus meets his afflicted mother. The Sixth Station; Veronica wipes the face of Jesus. (Britannica article St. Veronica: <https://www.britannica.com/biography/Saint-Veronica>) The Eighth Station: Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem (Luke 23:27, 28)

When Jesus calls us His friends (John 15:15), he goes on to say there is no greater love than to lay down one's life for their friend (John 15:13). With these and many other verses, Jesus elevates friendship to the highest level of love and equates it with eternal love in God.

Thinking about the friends of Jesus who were prepared for his death by Him.

After the feeding of the crowds of people Jesus explained his death. Matthew 16:21-23: ²¹ From that time on, Jesus began to show his disciples that he must go to Jerusalem and undergo great suffering at the hands of the elders and chief priests and scribes and be killed and on the third day be raised. ²² And Peter took him aside and began to rebuke him, saying, "God forbid it, Lord! This must never happen to you." ²³ But he turned and said to Peter, "Get behind me, Satan! You are a hindrance^[a] to me, for you are setting your mind not on divine things but on human things." (NRSVUE)

See Mark 8:31-32 and See Luke 9:21-22

After the Transfiguration

Matthew 17:9-13 ⁹ As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus ordered them, "Tell no one about the vision until after the Son of Man has been raised from the dead." ¹⁰ And the disciples asked him, "Why, then, do the scribes say that Elijah must come first?" ¹¹ He replied, "Elijah is indeed coming and will restore all things, ¹² but I tell you that Elijah has already come, and they did not recognize him, but they did to him whatever they pleased. So also the Son of Man is about to suffer at their hands." ¹³ Then the disciples understood that he was speaking to them about John the Baptist. (See also, Mark 9:30-34, and Luke 9:43-45)

Another time, as they were heading to Jerusalem to celebrate Passover, A Third Time Jesus Foretells His Death and Resurrection

Matthew 20:17-22 ¹⁷ While Jesus was going up to Jerusalem, he took the twelve disciples aside by themselves and said to them on the way, ¹⁸ "Look, we are going up to Jerusalem, and the Son of Man will be handed over to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn him to death; ¹⁹ then they will hand him over to the gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified, and on the third day he will be raised."

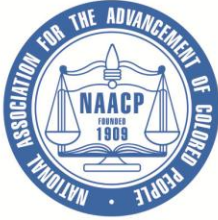

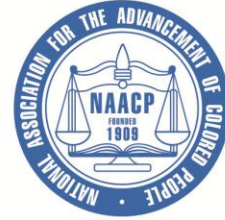

Romans 10:13 "For **whoever** calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved." (repeated @ Joel 2:32; Acts 2:21) "everyone, anyone who" asks. "Lord" here refers to God principally as in the book of Joel that is being quoted, so all persons who call on God shall be saved.
