Today is April 7, 2024, The Second Sunday of the Resurrection Season. In Acts Chapter One, verses 1-4, we read the following;

1 In the first book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and teach <sup>2</sup> until the day when he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. <sup>3</sup> After his suffering he presented himself alive to them by many convincing proofs, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. The Church provides us with a 40-day season of the resurrection to experience in real-time the number of days people experience the actual, physical Christ among them. Then, when you add the ten days following the Ascension of Christ into the heavens, we arrive at Pentecost, the day God gave the Holy Spirit, the promised Gift to the Church for the beginning of ministry; we have a 50-day Season called The Great Fifty Days. Continuing in the same place in Acts, Chapter One, starting at verse 4, we read:

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>4</sup>While staying<sup>[b]</sup> with them, he ordered them not to leave Jerusalem but to wait there for the promise of the Father. "This," he said, "is what you have heard

from me; <sup>5</sup> for John baptized with water, but you will be baptized with <sup>[C]</sup> the Holy Spirit not many days from now."

<sup>6</sup> So when they had come together, they asked him, "Lord, is this the time when you will restore the kingdom to Israel?" <sup>7</sup> He replied, "It is not for you to know the times or periods that the Father has set by his own authority. <sup>8</sup> But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." ALL: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25, 26)


Leader -2: In 1983, Ray Of Hope Church was started in part to form a unique

ministry to persons affected by and infected with HIV/AIDS. Forty-one years later, some churches, religions, and even some countries continue rejecting the sick, lonely, and dying people with HIV/AIDS who need spiritual guidance. In a letter from amfAR, The Foundation for AIDS Research, we learn every minute someone somewhere contracts HIV. In the year 2023, 1.5 million people became newly infected, and 650,000 people, including some from the United States, died of AIDS-related causes.

HIV/AIDS is still with us. Therefore, we continue to read aloud over **110,000** names sewn into the AIDS Memorial Quilt to keep HIV/AIDS in the conscious prayers of people.



#### **Jesus Appears to the Disciples**

<sup>19</sup> When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors were locked where the disciples were, for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." <sup>20</sup> After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. <sup>21</sup> Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I

send you." <sup>22</sup> When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. <sup>23</sup> If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained."

#### **Jesus and Thomas**

<sup>24</sup> But Thomas (who was called the Twin<sup>[a]</sup>), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. <sup>25</sup> So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe."

#### The Purpose of This Book

Now Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples that are not written in this book. <sup>31</sup> But these are written so that you may continue <sup>[b]</sup> to believe that Jesus is the Messiah, <sup>[c]</sup> the Son of God, and that through believing you may have life in his name.

John 21:24-25 New Revised Standard Version (NRSV)

<sup>24</sup> This is the disciple who is testifying to these things and has written them, and we know that his testimony is true. <sup>25</sup> But there are also many other things that Jesus did; if every one of them were written down, I suppose that the world itself could not contain the books that would be written.

#### + Sermon

Ray Of Hope Church teaches the same Christian faith of ancient ecumenical consensus. St. Vincent of Lerins, a fifth-century monk and theologian, described it as

"what has been believed always, everywhere, and by all."

2 Corinthians 4:5-6 <sup>5</sup> For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus's sake. <sup>6</sup> For it is the God who said, "Light will shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. (NRSVUE)

A few weeks ago, we read John 12:31-32 as part of our Gospel for the day.

<sup>31</sup> Now is the judgment of this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. <sup>32</sup> And I, when I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all people<sup>[a]</sup> to myself." <sup>33</sup> He said this to indicate the kind of death he was to die. (John 12:31-33 NRSVUE)

After reading those verses on the Second Sunday of the Season of the

Resurrection, two thoughts stand out for me today. First, Jesus was lifted up on the Cross, giving Himself as the payment for the wholesale rebellion of the Human Race against God. Jesus, having been obedient even to death (see <a href="Philippians 2:8">Philippians 2:8</a>), now has the authority over both the living and the dead. Romans 14:9 reads, <sup>9</sup> For to this end Christ died and lived again, so that he might be Lord of both the dead and the living. John 12:31 said the ruler of this world will be driven out. How, then, are we struggling with sin and evil in the world? Where is this Resurrection victory? If Christ is so victorious, why is everything in such chaos? Why is there chaos in my daily life, at home, work, school, and honestly, within myself? All of these are very fair questions. Before getting into it, my second thought was that Jesus promised to draw everyone to Himself. Jesus is "Lord of the living.." however, many of the living do not seem to care about their "Lord."

After reading these observations and questions, I realized that life doesn't seem like a victory on its face when I look all around me, beginning with my interior thoughts to as far away as the Internet can take me. Things do not seem very holy.

Many people today have decided the empirical evidence (what you can see is the proof) suggests there is no God, the whole Jesus story is just that, a religious story, and even to quote Carl Marx, who in 1843 wrote "religion [...] is the opium of the people" a drug of sorts to help people deal with the reality of life, survival, and death. In response, one might have a religious panic and say things like; more incense, please; change the lighting, next slide, sing another song, let's have a procession with trumpets. Then, after we have religious exercises, we feel better and return to the dangerous world on the other side of these walls. Yes, I suppose that is religion if the only purpose is to have a religious event. In the case of religious event planning, one can get lost in the production preparations, performance, and the final take-home product of religion.

I enjoy religion and religious practices very much, but only as tools that put me in touch, in contact, with the reality of the living real presence of the Creative Life-Giver, Who holds all that is with an interconnection that is inescapable anywhere and everywhere in places seen and unseen. There is no escaping the Reality Creator.

The people who were eyewitnesses to the pregnancy Mary accepted, the birth, life, death, resurrection, and the ascension of the Christ, known to them in the man, Jesus, were so moved by the experience of being with Him they were compelled from within their own spirits to tell others, and be able to help them find the experience of the same Living Christ. Knowing someone when they are alive and in front of us is one thing. Knowing the person, and experiencing their presence even after their death is highly unusual, but this is exactly what God gave those people who lived with Jesus, and this is what God has in mind for everyone alive today.

It is my responsibility to use every tool of religion and any other assistance available to help people from all walks of life find their connection to God. My natural place in this religious community is as a facilitator. Just as those who knew and experienced Jesus in His human life were motivated by the Holy Spirit to do everything within their purview to pass on the direct experience to others through written and lived testimony, so were the Founders and Foundresses of Ray Of Hope Church determined to share their lived experience.

Against so many circumstances of life in the 1940's to 1983, when they really put their testimony into action, these fourteen people were determined to tell everyone they were experiencing the living presence of the Risen Christ Jesus. It is difficult to put ourselves in their position and understand their circumstances in the early 1980s when churches were officially excluding us and making official statements declaring God would only see and understand us as lost sinners. Finally, many religious leaders and people in general even used the AIDS epidemic as proof that God hated and was judging "homoSEXuals." Even in all that noise and fear, the people who started Ray Of Hope knew they were definitely experiencing Christ truly present, and He was calling them to witness to His presence in the Church and in society through social action. Romans 8:9, 10, and 11 is just but one place where the original Members and Friends found their theological roots in Scripture.

Romans 8:9-11 But you are not in the flesh; you are in the Spirit, since the Spirit of God dwells in you. Anyone who does not have the Spirit of Christ does not belong to him. But if Christ is in you, then the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also through his Spirit that dwells in you. (NRSVUE

There are many Scripture verses where the Doctrine of the Trinity living within the willing believer is proven; however, time does not permit us to study them in this Sermon. It is interior motivation, interior awareness, and the interior emotional conversation where each person finds a connection to God. The Real Presence of the One God in Three Persons is the beginning of reality for all of us, for God gave each of us the Gift of Life. Our Founders and Foundresses formed an association to provide a physical place, with a group of actual people, where they could share their lived experiences of God in Christ, read the Sacred Scriptures together, experience the Teacher, the Comforter, the Guide in the Holy Spirit, pray for themselves and others, and invite everyone to the Sacred Holy Table of the Lord Jesus to receive His Real Presence in the Bread of Life and the Cup of Salvation. Those who began this Church also realized that when they prayed with devotion and trust, God heard their prayers, and they became instruments of change. They created a sacred place in their weekly schedules. Though the physical meeting place continued to move all over Central New York State, they discovered that wherever they pitched their spiritual tent and opened the doors, others came to share the experience of the Living Christ with them.

Choice. Choice and intentional relationship-building are sacred to God and sacred to Jesus. Even on the night before he died, Jesus allowed Judas to betray Him with a kiss, and Jesus allowed Peter to deny Him three times. Jesus also knew who would fall asleep and who would accompany Him into the depths of the garden to pray. Jesus knew who would choose to accompany Him even to the foot of the Cross. Jesus allowed each person the power of Holy Choice so that each individual would choose to build their relationship with God through Jesus and in the power of the Holy Spirit. Likewise, the world is in the condition it is in because Christ allows each individual to choose how they want to respond to the voice of God in the Church Age. Every day of our lives, we have the opportunity to choose to live more fully and be part of the Real Presence of Christ among us. We must be allowed to choose so that our relationship with Christ and the other Members of the Church will be authentic and genuine.

We readily see the fruits of choosing other paths than the opportunities Christ

lays out for us. The title "The Seven Deadly Sins" contains genuine truth, or choices that lead to spiritual and sometimes physical death. The opportunity for choosing will end either by our last breath or the last day of the Age of the Church. How God responds to those who choose to reject God even after meeting God in the hour of death is between each person and God alone.

In addition to prayer and study, the people of Ray Of Hope have always been deeply involved in social reform to help people everywhere reach the higher goals of universal love. In the interest of time, I will leave you with some significant Internet links to help you get up to speed with how the Lord's Name is being used in vain by politicians and governments. I ask you to read the stories associated with each link this week and pray for interior guidance and direction on how you can personally be involved in social reform and standing up for our Gospel principles.

- **uphold**, proclaim, and teach the historic Biblical Christian

  Doctrine, build community through worship and prayer, break the bread, and live the ministry of the Holy Spirit,
- **change** the World around us by living Gospel principles of social justice in everything we do, thereby exposing all forms of prejudice, oppression, racism, homophobia, sexism, and misogyny,
- proclaim the ray of hope, which is the soon coming return
   of Christ Jesus, and the fullness of His Eternal Community where the
   Will of God will establish liberty, justice, equity, and peace for all
   God's People and the Universe.
