**Bell's 1<sup>st</sup> ring.** As the bell rings, please find your seat and pray silently for the next few minutes. Please refrain from conversations as these disturb those trying to pray.

The St. Francis and St. Clare of Assisi bell at Ray Of Hope Church, 380 W. 1<sup>st</sup> St. in Elmira, NY, was a gift from Michael Quinnell of Syracuse, NY, in September 2005. The bell rings out 39 joyful rings, in contrast to tolling the bell in single rings. The 39 joyful rings honor the 39 lashes Jesus endured, and we now celebrate in Victory and gratitude for our Salvation. "The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes, we are healed." (Isaiah 53:5) We ring the bell before worship and Bible Enrichment sessions. Ray Of Hope Church officially began on 10/31/1983.

June 1, 2024, was the TWENTY-FIRST ANNIVERSARY OF THE OPENING OF THE ELMIRA CHAPEL.

Today is July 14, 2024, the nineteenth Sunday of the Season of Pentecost Year B in the cycle of Scripture readings.

Please take a moment to look around and notice the decorations, also called paraments from the Latin word parmentum meaning adornment; they are now green. The worship space is decorated according to local practice, how the Holy Spirit is understood to be speaking to the local assembly.

On my scale of "Doctrine, Dogma, Teaching, and Practice" that I started developing in the early 1980's, I place practices with very little authority when compared to Doctrines (which are at the top of importance). (N.B. Always remember some denominations switch the order to Dogma, Doctrine, Teaching, Practice. Be sure to establish your terms before

important discussions.) Here at our assembly, church decorating is a matter of Practice. Christians (of any tradition) who follow the approach to Christianity that St. Benedict started, use the worship space to show forth the meaning of Christ among us in design layout, and seasonal art, decorations and paraments. Benedictines use the chapel decorations to proclaim the Gospel. I mentioned a few weeks ago that our originating denomination founder Troy Perry preferred to keep red for all the Sundays from Pentecost to Advent in honor of the Holy Spirit. I like that practice of keeping red very much. However, over the years our not using green has been cited as one more oddity that some might point to when disapproving of Ray Of Hope; therefore the choice of red all season is reconsidered.

Since the Second Vatican Council (10/11/1962 - 12/8/1965) it has become the normal practice to count the Sundays not associated with important events in the Bible with ordinal numbers (numbers indicating position: first, second, third, fiftieth) and those Sundays associated with Doctrinal Importance especially associated with the life of Christ by using cardinal numbers(quantity or amount of time: Advent 1, Advent 2). Unfortunately the use of ordinal numbers has led to a popular misunderstanding that these indicate it is just an "ordinary time." In fact Ordinary Time indicates ordinal numbers, not a time that is not important. The color green is the liturgical color for Ordinary Time - indicating a season of spiritual growth, renewal, rebirth, new growth, learning and promise, possibility, and other forward-looking and growing ideas.

It is in the spirit of ecumenical partnership and cooperation that we use green for July, August, and some of September. As a acknowledgment of those among us who come from traditions where there are no coordinated liturgical seasons, readings, and colors, we take a complete break beginning in Fall and use harvest fall decorations until the Advent Week 1 (Notice the cardinal number Advent 1 of 4 weeks - quantity).

For a moment of contemporary humor and connection, think about the musical and film "The Wiz" where there is an entire sequence on the "color of the week" in the dance and set in the Emerald City. It is an artistic commentary on the pressure people often feel to keep up with whatever is the trend of the day. So, perhaps we might be yielding to some Emerald

City trend-setting peer pressure, but the color of the day is "Green." I can hear St. Kermit the frog singing "It's not that easy being green....." Green surely is a beautiful color.

**Leader -1:** Please be seated. Today, we light our Candle Of Hope to celebrate our faith and trust in the promised "Blessed Hope," also known as "The Rapture," the return of Christ who will transform the living faithful and raise all to new life. Jesus said: (John 5:25 and Titus 2:13)


ALL: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25, 26)

Leader -2: In 1983, Ray Of Hope Church was started in part to form a unique ministry to persons affected by and infected with HIV/AIDS. Forty-one years later, some churches, religions, and even some countries continue rejecting the sick, lonely, and dying people with HIV/AIDS who need spiritual guidance. In a letter from amfAR, The Foundation for AIDS Research, we learn every minute someone somewhere contracts HIV. In the year 2023, 1.5 million people became newly infected, and 650,000 people, including some from the United States, died of AIDS-related causes.

HIV/AIDS is still with us; therefore, we continue to read aloud over **110,000** names sewn into the AIDS Memorial Quilt to keep HIV/AIDS in the conscious prayers of people.






2 Corinthians 4:5-6 <sup>5</sup> For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. <sup>6</sup> For it is the God who said, "Light will shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. (NRSVUE)

Last week I directly answered the question of why God did not heal April from her cancer or her blindness for that matter. One main truth that answers this question is Jesus never said the mission of the Church would be to end all disease, end all human error, to end physical death. If Jesus had made those actions the function of the Church Age we would have to choose from some obvious conclusions such as:

- a) Every person who said they were Christian but died was not a real Christian because real Christians wouldn't die. All those people in all the cemeteries were lost souls because they became sick and died.
- b) The people who prayed for healing were not healed because they were not following God's will in their life.
- c) The people who were ministering the Sacraments were not really in touch with God.
- d) Jesus was a fraud.
- e) There is no God

You can see really quickly where this is going.

Last Sunday I stated if everyone who believed, or went to the Sacraments for healing, or "was saved" never became sick and never died, we would have two human races on the planet, the saved, resurrected, transformed perfect bodied eternal people and the others who have not had their "come to Jesus moment."

Here are the additional points for this week.

Some professional clergy even allow people to assume that people die because of some sin that is in their life. APRIL WAS TOLD BY ONE PRIEST THAT SHE WAS GOING TO HELL AND THERE WAS NOTHING SHE COULD DO ABOUT IT BECAUSE SHE MUTILATED HER BODY WITH HER TRANS SURGERY. SOME DENOMINATIONS ARE MAKING SIMILAR STATEMENTS WITHIN THE LAST YEAR. THIS IS A MAN-MADE LIE. THERE IS NOTHING IN THE BIBLE THAT SUPPORTS THIS LIE. Some pastors will say a disease that is not healed or a particularly tragic event that leads to a person dying is somehow a judgment from God.

The gospel reading today is about two situations, one being murder and the second having a building a tower fall on people, where some people thought these victims must have been in some kind of sin for this to happen. Twice, verse 3 and verse 5 Jesus firmly says "no" they were not punished. Then he throws the ball or responsibility back and says we must be people of confession and repentance if we plan to stay in the household of God.

JESUS states there is no punishment for sin through the manner of one's death be it plane crash, house fire, murder, war, or disease. All of those conditions are the result of human sin and humanity refusing to listen to God and follow God's will. In fact the holy Scriptures clearly state there is a time to be born and a time to die. Dying is as much a part of the human experience as being born is. The doctrine of the resurrection is NOT a Christian original

idea. The Book of Job is another source of knowing the people of the first testament believed in the Resurrection of the Dead.

- <sup>25</sup> For I know that my vindicator<sup>®</sup> (Redeemer) lives and that in the end he will stand upon the earth;
- <sup>26</sup> and after my skin has been destroyed, then in my flesh I shall see God,
- <sup>27</sup> whom I shall see on my side, and my eyes shall behold, and not another.

It is noteworthy that this reading is often read at Christian funerals and in our minds we think a Christian said it and wrote it. No, this is Job of the first testament. We can stop and understand some of the response when Jesus identified himself as the Resurrection and the Life. He was clearly declaring his divinity. Martha, a sister of Lazarus said; "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." (John 11:24) Martha had learned of resurrection from the Scriptures. Try to imagine the moment that followed (11:25) when Jesus identified himself as the Resurrection.

In fact, the Scriptures tell us there is a time to be born and a time to die. Ecclesiastes Chapter 3

- **3** For everything there is a season and a time for every matter under heaven:
- <sup>2</sup> a time to be born and a time to die;
- a time to plant and a time to pluck up what is planted;
- <sup>3</sup> a time to kill and a time to heal;
- a time to break down and a time to build up;
- <sup>4</sup> a time to weep and a time to laugh;
- a time to mourn and a time to dance;
- <sup>5</sup> a time to throw away stones and a time to gather stones together;
- a time to embrace and a time to refrain from embracing;
- <sup>6</sup> a time to seek and a time to lose;
- a time to keep and a time to throw away;
- <sup>7</sup> a time to tear and a time to sew;
- a time to keep silent and a time to speak;
- <sup>8</sup> a time to love and a time to hate;
- a time for war and a time for peace.

It is Interdependence, Cooperation, Community, what we hold in common, and in Holy Communion that matters eternally and will give us true freedom.

With these words comfort one another. 1 Thessalonians 4:18 Remarks by Rev. Br. Shawn F. Benedict, O. S. B. 7-7-24 and 7-14-24

Today's Second Reading is one of the most beautiful sections of Scripture regarding our lives. Ephesians 1:3 <sup>3</sup> Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, Every spiritual blessing in all of creation is ours.

Ephesians 1:4 just as he chose us in Christ<sup>10</sup> before the foundation of the world to be holy and blameless before him in love. God chose you and knew you before this planet existed.

Ephesians 1:5 <sup>5</sup>He destined us<sup>11</sup> for adoption as his children<sup>12</sup> through Jesus Christ, according to the good pleasure of his will, God was pleased, thrilled to determine that you and I would be born during the Church Age so we could be "in Christ" in the Church, to be LGBTQSIANE2ss+++ CHRISTIANS in this time at this place.

Ephesians 1:6 <sup>6</sup> to the praise of his glorious grace that he freely bestowed on us in the Beloved. We are here to praise God for God's glorious grace, love, cherishing that God lavishes on us through Christ. 
