Leader - 1: Please be seated. Today, we light our Candle Of Hope to show by this action of lighting this candle again that we celebrate our faith and trust in the promised "Blessed Hope," also known as "The Rapture," the return of Christ who will transform the living faithful and raise all to new life. I invite you to say these words of Jesus again to celebrate the Truth they promise us. Jesus said: (John 5:25 and Titus 2:13)

ALL: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25, 26)

Leader -2: In 1983, Ray Of Hope Church was started in part to form a unique ministry to persons affected by and infected with HIV/AIDS. Our witness to God's love for all people is as relevant today as it was then. Here we are forty-one years later, and some churches, religions, and, yes, even some countries continue rejecting the sick, lonely, and dying people with HIV/AIDS who need spiritual guidance. In a letter we recently received from amfAR, The Foundation for AIDS Research, we learn every minute that someone somewhere contracts HIV; today, right now, think about it. In the year 2023, 1.5 million people became newly infected, and 650,000 people, including some from the United States, died of AIDS-related causes.

HIV/AIDS is still with us; therefore, at Ray Of Hope Church Of Our Lord Jesus Christ, we continue to read aloud over **110,000** names sewn into the AIDS Memorial Quilt to keep HIV/AIDS in the conscious prayers of people.

Leader-3: Jesus told the Church to forgive sins in His Name. Jesus said:

ALL: If you forgive people their sins, your heavenly Father will also






REFLECTIONS ON TODAY'S READINGS

The Angel Of The Lord = Summary on page 341 of the Scofield III, NKJV Bible (find to <u>order here</u>) Christ in his pre-incarnate form appearing, meaning to be manifested visibly, to save a believer from peril or even death.

Last week, in the Book of Proverbs, we learned that Wisdom has set her table for us and invites us to come to Her Table and eat Her bread and drink Her wine. In the second reading from Ephesians, we learned we could accept and grow in the Wisdom of God, and in the Gospel, Jesus introduced the New Bread and the New Cup, the Eucharist, where He would remain with us to the end of the Church Age. The Eucharist continues to provide new Wisdom every time we celebrate at the Table of Christ, the Living Bread.

Two weeks ago, we had 1 Kings 19:4-8; Elijah is touched twice by The Angel of The Lord, who provides warm bread on hot stones and water for Elijah for both his spiritual and physical well-being.

Three weeks ago, we read Exodus 16:4 ⁴ · Then the LORD said to Moses, "I am going to rain Bread from Heaven for you, and each day the people shall go out and gather enough for that day."

Four weeks ago, we read 2 Kings 4:43b, where Elisha tells the servant to give the people the barley loaves to the people: So he repeated, "Give it to the people and let them eat, for thus says the LORD: They shall eat and have some left."

Today, we have the fifth of five Sundays reviewing the Doctrine of the Bread Of Life. Last Sunday, we ended by thinking about the Wisdom of God expressed as the Church, building "her house" and inviting all to "come in" and sit at her table to eat bread and drink her wine (Proverbs 9:5). There is something else I

want to say about that reading. According to most ancient authorities, I could have pointed out that the church has seven sacraments. Perhaps this could be the seven pillars her house is built upon (Proverbs 9:1), but it might also be the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit known as the seven spirits of God in Revelation 1:4 or even other meanings. In all this, we see Jesus, the Head of the Church, His Body in the world. (Colossians 1:18) We see the precious bread and wine inside the house as The Blessed Sacrament. This is all God's wisdom. We also see that the church is the Bride of Christ, and He is her husband.

Romans 7:4 ⁴ Therefore, my brethren, you also have become dead to the law through the body of Christ, that you may be married to another—to Him who was raised from the dead, that we should bear fruit to God.

Human knowledge will never be able to scientifically analyze and explain how Jesus is fully present with us in His resurrected self through the Holy Spirit. (Isaiah 41:10; Matt 28:20) No scientific study we currently have can study and explain this phenomenon. Also, no scientific method can explain how simple bread and simple fruit of the vine become the real flesh and real blood of Jesus as He promised it would. (John 6:55) Further, no scientific method will ever be able to explain how all the powers of eternal life are brought forth through the transformation of earthly food and drink into spiritual food and drink that gives the power of eternal life. Verse 51: Jesus said to them, ⁵¹ I am the living bread that came down from heaven. Whoever eats of this bread will live forever; the bread that I will give for the life of the world is my flesh."

Today, we have John Chapter 6, verse 66. 666 represents the number of man at our worst spiritual selves, the number of anti-Christ. What is happening at this moment in the Bread Of Life Gospel? Many of His disciples refused to follow Him from that day forward. Why? Because they found the Doctrine of the Real Presence too difficult to rationalize and, therefore, impossible to believe. This reason for not accepting the Real Presence continues to be the case today. Millions of Christians do not believe in the Real Presence, and worse, they teach others to deny it, too. Still, others have taken the Doctrine of the Real Presence and made it out to be for "re"-presenting a perpetual

In my opinion, both extremes are wrong as I see them.



In my observation, during the first 1,000 years, the Church clearly and unanimously believed that Christ was literally present in the Eucharist; it is unquestionable. These were disciples of the Apostles, meaning the Apostles almost definitely taught the real presence of Christ in the Eucharist. I observe the conflicts that later arise over this question about the Real Presence are concerning how this change takes place, a question no mortal can answer, not because it is idiotic or ridiculous, but only because it is an operation of the eternal Divine God, not our doing. 
