Jesus said: (John 5:25 and Titus 2:13)

ALL: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die." (John 11:25, 26)

Leader -2: In 1983, Ray Of Hope Church was started in part to form a unique ministry to persons affected by and infected with HIV and AIDS and to extend a radical welcome to all people to worship with us. Our witness to God's unconditional love for everyone is as relevant today as in 1983. Here we are forty-one years later, and still, some churches, religions, and, yes, even some countries continue rejecting the sick, lonely, and dying people with HIV and AIDS who deserve comfort and spiritual guidance. Scientists have proven AIDS was never a "gay disease," and it remains a health crisis for the entire Human Race. In a September 18, 2024 post from the Southern Tier AIDS Program we read the following:

Let's raise awareness and continue to advocate for the needs of our aging population living with HIV. Your support helps us make a difference every day.

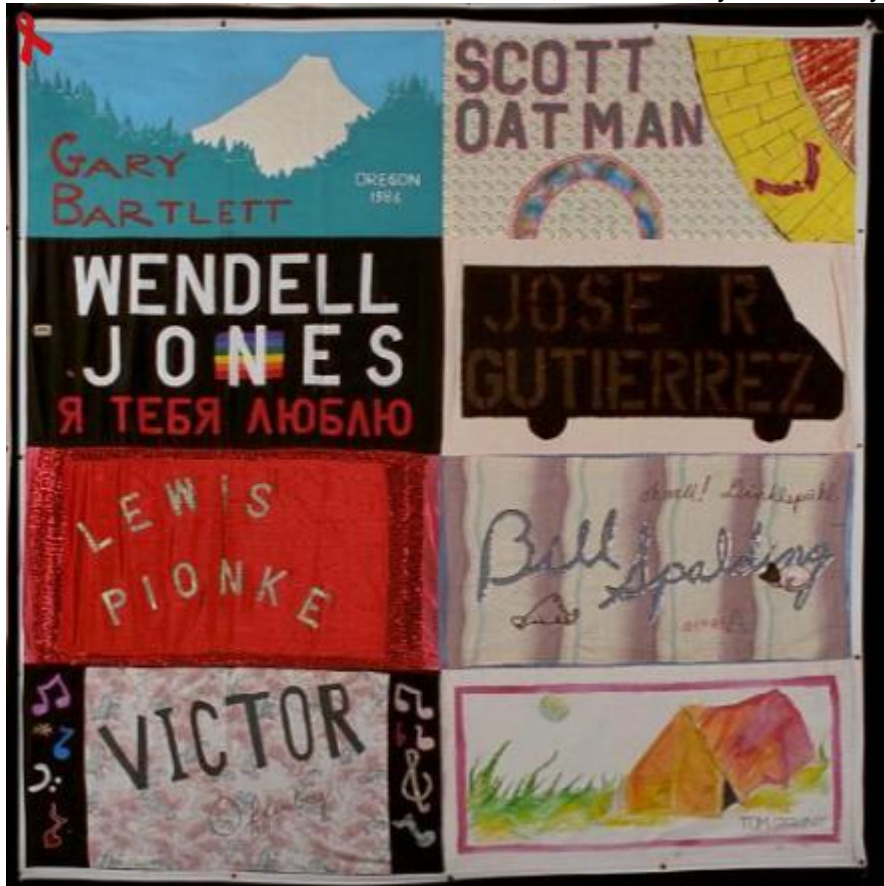

2 Corinthians 4:5-6 ⁵ For we do not proclaim ourselves; we proclaim Jesus Christ as Lord and ourselves as your slaves for Jesus' sake. ⁶ For it is the God who said, "Light will shine out of darkness," who has shone in our hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Christ. (NRSVUE)

Ray Of Hope Church Of Our Lord Jesus Christ, Inc. is the name of this ministry. The only name associated with this ministry is the "Name above all names." (see Philippians 2:8-11)

In the Psalm, "The Lord upholds my life, Alleluia." We have choices, many choices all the time. Some choices and options bring us closer to the will of God in our lives, and others allow us to drift off into our own direction and we wander, sometimes into places previously unknown and dangerous.

James 3:16 – 4:3

¹⁶ For where there is envy and selfish ambition, there will also be disorder and wickedness of every kind. ¹⁷ But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without a trace of partiality or hypocrisy. ¹⁸ And the fruit of righteousness^[a] is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Friendship with the World

4 Those conflicts and disputes among you, where do they come from? Do they not come from your cravings that are at war within you? ² You want something and do not have it, so you commit murder. And you covet^[b] something and cannot obtain it, so you engage in disputes and conflicts. You do not have because you do not ask. ³ You ask and do not receive because you ask wrongly, in order to spend what you get on your pleasures.

Mark 9:35b-37 who is the greatest ? really?

"Whoever wants to be first must be last of all and servant of all." ³⁶ Then he took a little child and put it among them, and taking it in his arms he said to them, ³⁷ "Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me, and whoever welcomes me welcomes not me but the one who sent me."

The world works hard to seduce us away from the Scriptures, away from prayer, away from the worship community. The Scriptures, the prayers, and the community of the Beloved Son Of God are all put into our paths to call out to us and attempt to encourage us to choose God.

We choose Christ. So Baptism.....



SPECIAL OPPORTUNITY TO MAKE A GIFT DONATION. FROM VERONICA FLOYD, CLERK

Dear Friends and Members,

On Monday afternoon the Carbon Monoxide Alarms rang on the first floor of the church and monastery. It turns out the broken bolt and old seal (apparently one was not replaced in the last kit replacement) on the existing boiler were allowing Carbon Monoxide to leak out of the boiler and upstairs through the floor and walls. The boiler is shut off and the system is taken off line because it is leaking Carbon Monoxide. The heat to the entire building is off until the Heat Exchanger Kit is installed.

We have received an estimate from Isaac Heating & Air Conditioning of \$3,230.79 to cover the parts and time it takes two technicians to do the exchange which is approximately 6 hours. This is the initial estimate for phase 1 of repairs needed. There will be a second estimate to add a larger pump to solve the problem of getting the heat upstairs and to the back corners of the building. We wanted to share what we know now with everyone, additional details will be shared as known.

The Council will meet on Thursday, September 26th to finalize the plans to get this urgent repair completed and we are requesting any donations to help with the cost of the repair.

We thank all of you for your past generosity and for any financial assistance you can give at this time towards the boiler repair.

The goal is to get the parts ordered and repair scheduled before we need the boiler to be operational with the temperature declines.

The estimate is only good for 30 days so we must act quickly but we want to also be responsible with ensuring we can pay for the repair.

Thank you in advance for your support. Any amount given will be of great support.

There were 2 people who deposited their August donations in July, so this figure is lower than normal by about \$800.00 Pastoral compensation of \$495.00 per week was paid, Verizon \$62.13, a reimbursement to me for the wine and grape juice kits of \$91.44 and Paypal charge comes out of this account. After these were paid the ending balance of this account at the end of the month was \$265.34.

Building Fund opening balance was \$1,357.42. Donations to the Building Fund were as follows: Brother Shawn Benedict \$640.00, Kaiden Benedict \$400.00. I transferred back in from Savings \$662.33 also. Regular bills that came out of the fund this month was the Credit Card bill with Key Bank of \$61.42, electric \$233.92 (which has increased \$100 per month), gas bill

\$253.00, water bill \$82.79, Fire Inspection fee of \$60.00, Isaac's Plumbing and Heating \$364.95 and I paid the Liability Insurance bill of \$662.33. Ending balance of this fund was \$1,341.34.

Building Improvement Fund opening balance on this account was \$2,452.49. We had no activity on this account during August. Ian & Christinas donation was done on Paypal September 1st, so that will be on next month's report. So the ending balance on this account is \$2,452.29.

Savings (Council) Account opening balance \$705.33. I transferred \$662.33 to the building fund to cover the liability insurance payment, so the ending balance in this account is \$43.65.

These balances do equal the ending bank balances.

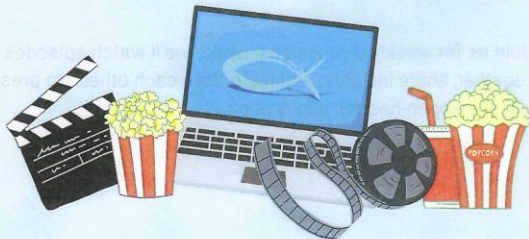

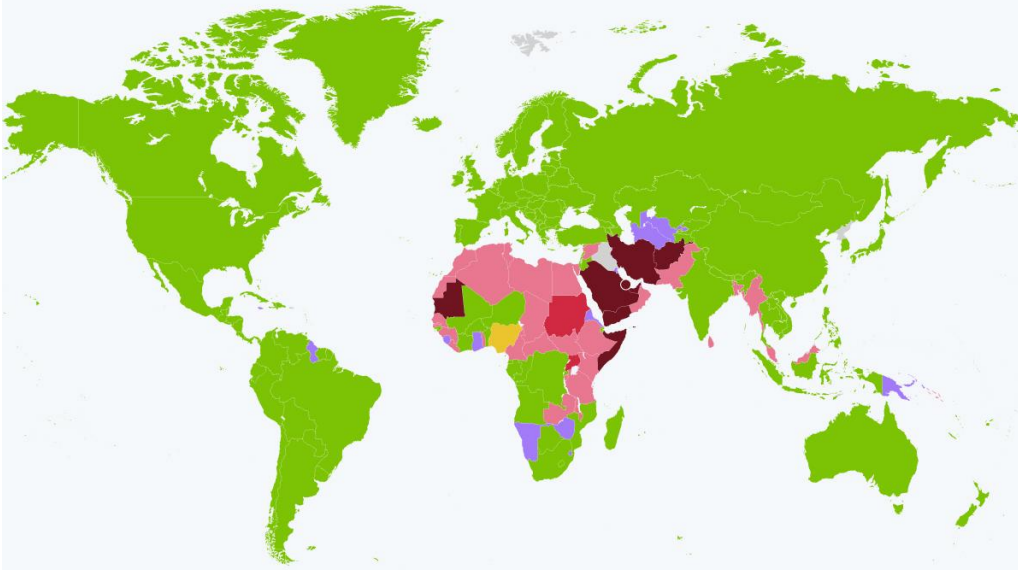
